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Exhibit Floor to Showcase Latin America's Enhanced Full Package Capabilities

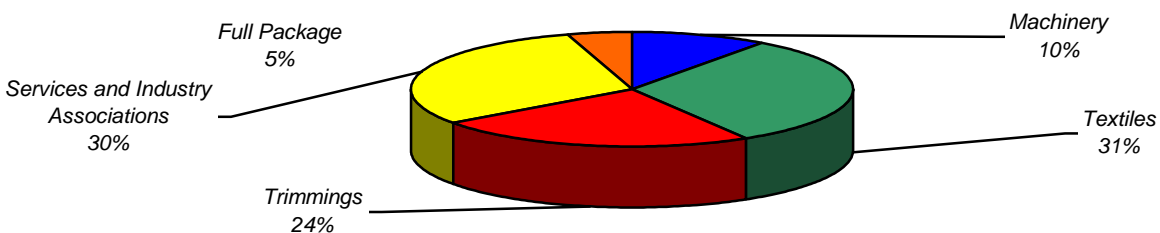
